Important Message: Training Attendance

It has been great to see so many members attending our first two training sessions this week. Unfortunately, however, there has already been athletes attending our Wednesday Senior Training Session without adequate parental supervision at the oval. As part of the registration and insurance policy for Little Athletics WA, ALL athletes attending training or competitions must have a parent or designated responsible adult (18+) in attendance on the oval in order for them to train/compete. All members are to be signed in at the start of each training session as a record of this understanding and so we know which athletes are training during that session. Going forward, any athlete who attends training sessions or competitions without adequate parental supervision will be unable to train or compete until this requirement has been met.

Don't forget we also need parents to assist with the training sessions, we have volunteer qualified coaches but still need your help with some of the training program support.

Competition Rosters – Sob of even Lob tedW **Enisode 2- Field Sites**

Last week we introduced the Set Up, Pack Up and Canteen Rosters and reminded families of the requirement of a MINIMUM of 5 Rosters with the expectation of being rostered on every fortnight.

This week we take a look at the Field Sites. Field Sites are the main part of the competition and require the most parent helpers each week with between 3 and 4 adults being required to effectively and efficiently run the site.

At each of the Field Sites there will be a qualified Key Official who will assist you in running the competition site to a high standard. If you require any assistance or have any questions, please speak to your Key Official or one of the Field Referees.

Field Site Rosters require parental assistance throughout the entire morning.

Field Site rosters commence at 7.30am and conclude once the site has been packed up following the conclusion of the final event. The finishing time will vary from site to site, week to week.

Upon arrival at 7.30am please assist your sites Key Official in setting up your site for competition to commence at 8am.

*All sites will have a qualified Kev Official allocated as well as the following rostered Parent Helpers.

For the 2016/2017 Season Mindarie Mustangs have been allocated the following sites to operate:

> **High Jump Flop Site A High Jump Flop Site B Discus Site A Shot Put Site A**

Jumps—High Jump

High Jump consists of 2 Sites with 2 roster positions per site. Each site will require parent helpers to complete the following tasks:

- Recorder—Record the clearances or failures of athletes during 1. the event.
- Bar Judge—Assist the Key Official in raising/replacing the bar 2. throughout the competition.

Throws—Shot Put and Discus

Each discipline consists of 1 Site with 3 roster positions per site. Each site will require parent helpers to complete the following tasks:

- 1. Recorder—Record the distance achieved by athletes.
- 2. Spiker—Place the marker at the closest point of contact to the throwing circle.
- 3. Retriever—Assist in walking the implements back to the throwing circle for use by the next athletes.

Your support and assistance in attending to these sites is greatly appreciated by the athletes as well as the Club and Centre Committees.

Mindarie Mustangs will also require at least 1 Set Up Assistant, 1 Pack Up Assistant and 2 Canteen Helpers as highlighted in last weeks Newsletter.
